

They're Bombay students. You might even be personally friendly with a few of them. The girls will be sporting special JS scarves and the boys in trendy Liberty shirts.


The idea is to spot them, go up and introduce yourself and, if you are amongst the first six to do so, win yourself a free six-month subscription to the JS magazine.
